- 3. **Submit Your Work:** Submit the compiled templates and summary to your instructor, adhering to any specific formatting or submission guidelines in your syllabus.
- 4. **Prepare for Discussion:** Be ready to discuss your findings in class or during assessment, emphasising how AI contributed to your creative process.
